ATTRACTIONS

Titanic Belfast tells the story of the RMS Titanic from her conception in Belfast in the early 1900's, through her construction and launch, to its maiden voyage and subsequent place in history. titanicbelfast.com

SS Nomadic is the world's last remaining White Star vessel and RMS Titanic's original tender ship, now restored to her original glory and back home in Belfast's historic Hamilton Dock. Admission onboard SS Nomadic is included with the Titanic Experience ticket.

RSPB Window on Wildlife Belfast's Window on Wildlife (WOW) is home to birds and wildlife from all over the world. There are more than 100 species of birds and other wildlife to be found here, from lapwings and terns to konik ponies. RSPB.org.uk

HMS Caroline is the last known surviving warship from one of the largest naval battles ever fought - 1916's Battle of Jutland. It features a wealth of maritime artefacts reflecting its maritime connections, and also includes designs by William Morris. 
