Attractions along the Maritime Mile offer a dynamic mix of maritime history, entertainment, and waterfront fun. Kids and adults alike can enjoy interactive experiences, scenic walks, and hands-on learning. With plenty of engaging activities both indoors and out, it's the perfect spot for a family fun and educational day out.

Titanic Belfast tells the story of the Titanic from her conception in Belfast in the early 1900's, through her construction and launch, to its maiden voyage and subsequent place in history. titanicbelfast.com

SS Nomadic is the world's last remaining White Star vessel and RMS Titanic's original tender ship, now restored to her original glory and back home in Belfast's historic Hamilton Dock. Admission onboard SS Nomadic is included with the Titanic Experience ticket.

W5 is Belfast's award-winning science and discovery centre. Step into a world of wonder and explore over 250 hands-on exhibits that offer limitless fun for all the family. w5online.co.uk

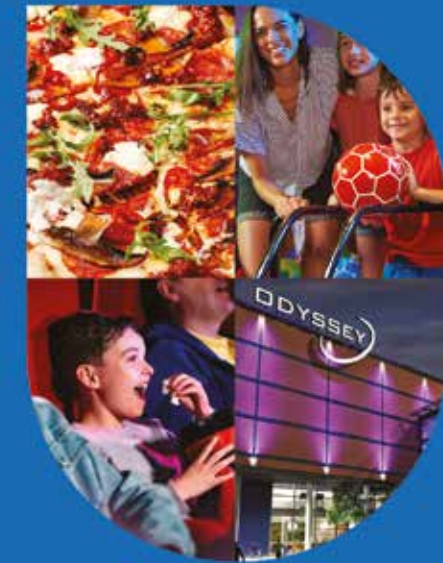
